Application

Please check the application deadline and requirements of the program of your choice. All applicants, regardless where they earned their degree, have to apply via the online application portal "move-in" of Bielefeld University. As soon as you have received a positive reply on the online portal (admission notice of the faculty), you can enrol or transfer within the set deadline. Bielefeld University uses a written enrolment procedure. The enrolment documents must be handed in by mail to the Student Office by the closing date for registration.

Language Requirements

For programs partly taught in English, German language proficiency must be proven at the time of application. This proof needs to be delivered by handing in an official language certificate unless you are a native speaker or have graduated from a German-speaking program. Accepted certificates are, among others, the Goethe-Zertifikat, the TestDaF and the Deutsche Sprachdiplom der Kultusministerkonferenz.
