Application Deadline: August 31, 2025

Duration of Program: 3 months

(in the spring term / Sommersemester 2026

 an internship at a company/organization in the New York Metropolitan Area or other region (usually 3 months, longer possible)

includes 1-week leadership & intercultural Skills
 Seminar (business culture, leadership skills, diversity etc.)

a virtual workshop to reflect on the internship experience.



- Payment/Salary is up to the internship provider (paid/unpaid)
- Estimated expenses: > \$2000 monthly
 - \$1000 \$1500 accommodation
 - \$130 transportation (NYC monthly metro card / OMNY Card)
 - > \$500 living expenses
 - \$40 health insurance
 - Other costs, like phone plan etc.
 - Plus flights! (\$600 \$1300)

Internship Placement & VISA Guidelines



Internship Placement

• Once accepted to the program (after the interview), candidates get placement support from Campus OWL New York. It is important that every candidate shows initiative in this process, either by sharing their own ideas for internships or by securing their own internship independently. There is no guarantee that an internship placement will be successful.

VISA Guidelines

- Visa Regulations Students who are accepted by the internship provider need to apply for a J-1 visa (J-1 exchange visitor visa for interns). The internship must have a clear relation to the candidate's academic education and must be highly relevant to the future career development and existing background of the candidate. The German American Chamber of Commerce in New York (GACCNY) is the cooperating and supporting partner in the PEP program. GACCNY can sponsor the J-1 visa for internships in a variety of sectors...
- However, GACCNY cannot sponsor visas in activities such as teaching, health/medical/social work, in the arts (music, design, theater, etc.), and the government sector.
